When you come to pray

Come into Church through the West door. There will be someone there from Church to let you know what to do. Please use the hand sanitiser provided, and then enter along the 'IN' route. The inside of Church might look a little different from what you expect, things have been changed to make your visit as safe as we can do.



Do I have to wear a mask? No, if you maintain social distancing but if it makes you feel more comfortable, please do so.



Will my visit be timed? Not at present, but please be mindful of others if there is a queue.

Once inside

The steward will show you where you may sit. Pews are either open or closed. Open pews have a sign and closed ones are roped off for your safety.



Will I be able to use a kneeler? Not at the moment, but it may be possible soon. Bibles and hymn books have also been removed. If you need a hymn book or bible for home use, please ask.

Can I light a candle? No, but at the front of church there are Palm Crosses placed on the floor to help us remember those who have died recently. You might find it helpful to stand by the benches or kneel there.
